Summer 2017 Information

Program Dates: Monday, June 12th, 2017 – August 4th, 2017 (8 weeks)

Ages: 1 year up to completion of 1st grade

Camp hours are 9:00 am to 2:00 pm.

Cost: \$100.00 per week per child

* There will be before care available 7:30 am to 9:00 am @ \$5.00 an hour for one child or \$7.00 an hour for 2 children.

* We will also have after care from 2:00 pm to 5:30 pm., same rate as morning care. 20% discount available for before and after care when you pay a block of time in advance.

This year our summer program will consist of 8, one week camps. Pick and choose what you like and what works for your schedule. There is a 5% sibling discount.

We will need a minimum of 10 students per week to cover expenses. If a week does not make you will receive a credit to be used on a different week or to go toward the fall. If you paid for a week and do not attend then you will forfeit that weeks payment. Your 1/3 down payment is not refundable if you choose to not attend the summer program after registering.
